When You Arrive

The bus will drop you off at the parking lot of Tynsky's Law Office or alternatively at Green River Parks & Rec at W 2nd N and W 1st E. You and your students can make your way along the sidewalks to the front door of the Sweetwater County Museum. **Please plan for the bus to arrive at least 10 minutes before your assigned time slot.** There the group will be split apart into two groups. Depending on your time slot, you may be with another school and will be divided accordingly.

Museum Mode

Many schools will overlap at least some of their time between the museum and the park. When everyone is respectful and thoughtful, History Fair is more fun! Encourage students to practice their manners with Museum Mode.

Bus Driver Instructions

- From Flaming Gorge Way, turn up N 1st E St. Then turn left into Tynsky Law Office parking.
 - Drop students on NW side of Law Building next to Clocktower Park.
- Alternatively, drop students at the corner of W 2nd N and N 1st E by the Parks & Rec building entrance.
- Proceed back to Flaming Gorge Way
- Turn up N 2nd W St. at Centennial Park and proceed to Bus Parking which will be marked.
 - Students will load up at Centennial Park

During Your Visit

- ADA Accessible portable restrooms are available for student and teacher use in the Museum Parking Lot. The restrooms at Centennial Park are also open for History Fair use.
- An elevator is available for ADA access into the Museum from the parking lot.
- A sunscreen, water, and basic first aid station is available outside the Museum at the John Wesley Powell statue and at the Centennial Park Gazebo.

Schedule

To keep History Fair operating smoothly, we encourage you to look at your group's schedule. You've been assigned a time slot and below you can find where your class should be at any given time. There are short breaks between each activity and a longer break to walk to Centennial Park. Please plan to be **dropped off by your bus at least 10 minutes before your assigned start time** to allow time to walk to the front of the museum.
